State Affiliate Tournament (@CHS): Gordons & Oxriders

- Proposed menu:

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NEW ITEMS/QUESTIONS:

- Globals – Kansas City – Total fees \$5500 (+ things like gas, food, souvenirs, etc)
 - **Non-refundable** deposit of \$1500 due April 13 for Globals registrations
 - Decision needed this month re: \$\$ allocation
 - We have 17 teams that are eligible to go to Globals
 - 2 confirmed yes
 - 5 maybes
 - 2 elementary teams are waiting to hear about financial assistance
 - 4 definite no
 - In the past, Dr. Henderson had agreed to subsidize CDI with \$5000 PO pmt directly towards registration fees
 - They are willing to do this again this year
 - In 2019, we set up a budget where we'd give the TMs per diem for hotel and food
 - Remainder was evenly distributed
 - Harry will determine average daily cost of hotels
 - NO shuttles this year, DI has booked three downtown hotels and two out by the airport
 - They *will* offer a shuttle from there to the center
 - Proposing we cover daily hotel cost, \$30ish/day for food
 - Cover expenses for five days
 - Under the old pricing, comes out to roughly \$800/team
 - Things we need to determine:
 - What is our total budget?
 - \$16,000, assuming every TM goes
 - What is budget per team?
 - Could potentially have 11 teams go if all are “yes”
 - 24 TM
 - Need to have a cap per team
 - Proposal we match the CCS \$5000, with limit of \$1000/team (does not include TMs, just is for registration)
 - For TMs, will average daily hotel costs and \$30 per diem (max \$200/day)
 - **Motion carried unanimously**
 - Who are we supporting? (everyone, just those who place, etc)
 - Harry motions that we support anyone who wants to go
 - Vote = 6 for, 3 against
 - **Motion carries – We support anyone who wants to go**
 - Jose would prefer only those who place at State
 - Larger teams pay less
 - Deb motioned to support DCs the same way we do TMs
