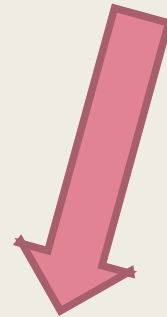



JUST LIKE DI IS FOR THE KIDS!!

IC DAY WAS A DUMPSTER FIRE. HELP !!???!!!!!!!!

IT'S NORMAL.

It's fine.

You're fine.

It's designed to push the kids into "worst case" scenarios.



LEARN FROM IT.

Did your team crash & burn on performances or building/tasks?

Why? What happened?

Keep offering them IC practice time!

ANXIETY? Team = 2.

Instant Challenge – NO ONE WAY IS THE RIGHT WAY!

- ▶ Interference, schmenterference. **YOU CAN TEACH INSTANT CHALLENGE!!**
- ▶ ROLES. Look on TM Hub for this → document. →
- ▶ Prep ideas – characters, setting.
- ▶ Divide & conquer!
- ▶ DO NOT TOUCH MATERIALS!!!
- ▶ Exploring Material Properties (hint: TM Hub).
- ▶ **ALERT! ALERT!: Make sure kids know only ONE TM can go in with them, and parents know that NO PARENTS can go into the building.**
- ▶ **PRE-IC? It's all about MENTAL PREPARATION.**

IC ROLES

TIME KEEPER

Helps team keep on task in terms of time limits

ASSEMBLERS / BUILDERS

Responsible for physical construction of solution

MATERIALS PERSON

Responsible for prepping materials for Assemblers (ripping, arranging, etc...)

PAPER / RULES PERSON

Makes sure team is following challenge details by referring back to challenge constantly throughout the solving of the challenge

STORY CREATORS – SONG CREATORS

Responsible for creating the skit / story / songs for performances

FLOATER

Helps out where & when needed

BREAK IT DOWN...

What do we have to do? (Reach, move, build, perform, etc...)

What should we do first?

Should we divide the tasks to be more productive? (Some assemble while others work on skit / song / dance)

What rules must you absolutely remember?
(Lines you can or can't cross, materials that can't be part of the solution, items that have to be used, etc...)

What parts get the most points? (Check for height, weight held, how many, distance, creative use of materials)

REGION 12 TOURNAMENT



▶ **SATURDAY, MARCH 12th**

- ▶ PLAN ON AN ALL-DAY “EVENT”!!
- ▶ RISING STARS: At the end of your CC, “Awards”. (Even if you have not yet done your IC.)
- ▶ COMPETITIVE TEAMS: Award Ceremony (optional) at tentatively scheduled for 5 pm.
- ▶ FOOD (because we know that’s what the kids will be concerned about LOL!): Pack lunch &/or Sinclair Cafeteria will be open.
 - ▶ Dinner – AT YOUR DISCRETION – it’s often fun for the kids & families to meet up afterwards for dinner. Making a 7-7:30 pm reservation for the group should allow enough time for Awards, “Going to State” Info meeting, & travel back to Centerville.

CHALLENGES

Instant Challenge – Only team members and ONE Team Manager. NO AUDIENCE.

Central Challenge – The team’s play performance. All competitive teams should have their scripts memorized.

“Appraiser Challenge” – After performance, Appraisers will approach team members & ask them questions.

UH, OH – MY TEAM HASN'T EVEN THOUGHT ABOUT...

THEIR TEAM SIGN.

Good news! As a NON-SCORED ELEMENT, it doesn't matter what it looks like – it just has to be free-standing; at least 2x3; and have their team name, school, level (RS, EL, ML, SL), & most importantly – TEAM NUMBER – on it.

PICKING TEAM CHOICE ELEMENTS.

DOING ALL THEIR PAPERWORK.

HOW THEY ARE GOING TO GET THEIR STUFF THERE.

- How big / bulky are your costumes, props, & materials?
- Do any parents have cargo vans, extra van space, SUV, pick-up trucks, trailer / access to a trailer?
- DON'T WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE – ARE YOU SURE THE PROPS WILL FIT ****OUT**** OF THE DOORWAY OF YOUR MEETING LOCATION????

TEAM CHOICE ELEMENTS (TCE)

IMPROV = 0

RISING STARS = 1

ALL OTHER CHALLENGES = 2

- INTEGRATED / essential to story.
- ISOLATED – *NOT* a current scored element.

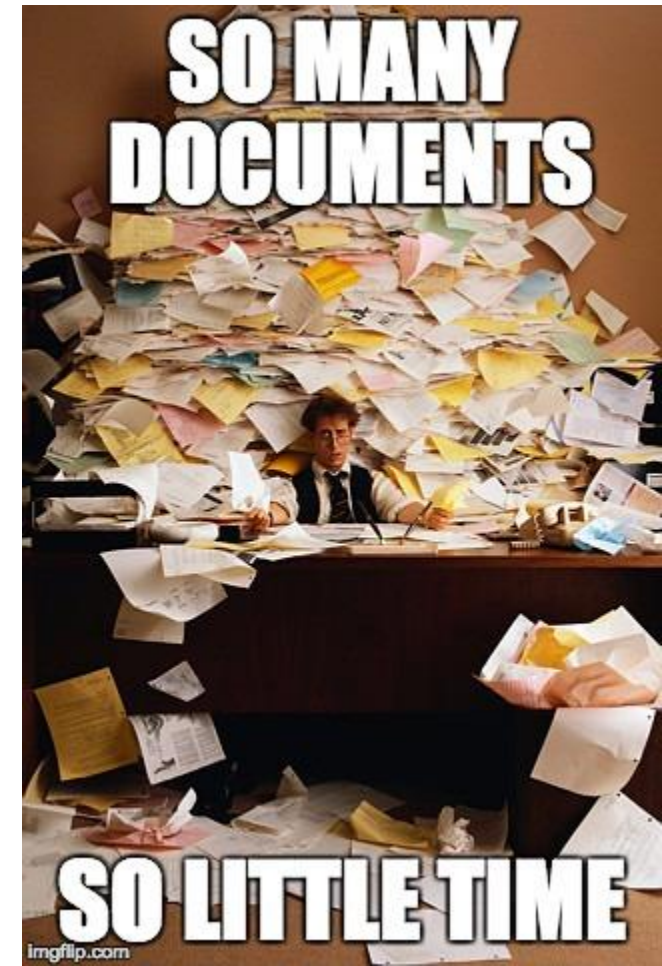
TCE, “Describe/Explain” scoring elements, “The Creative Process”.

Clothing, Scenery/Equipment, Props, Common Supplies, Trash.



WHAT CAN I DO?? WHAT SHOULD I BE DOING??

EMPHASIZE, RE-EMPHASIZE, AND RE-RE-EMPHASIZE:

- “Is this necessary to get your through Regionals? Is this a scored element? What is most important to finish?”
- “When is the last time you read your challenge from beginning to end? Are you sure you have hit all your scoring elements?”
- “Is this the best use of your time?”
- “You only have ___ days left.”

Not only do you need to continue to encourage your team, make sure you:

- Schedule enough meetings – even if not everyone is available! 3 WORDS.
- **PREPARE YOUR PARENTS** – especially first-time DI Parents!
 - Schedule, schedule, schedule! – Be prepared!
 - No interference – keep hands, arms, & voices inside the ride at all times!
- Goody bags? (Ask for volunteers?!?)
- REPAIR KIT.
- Work on transport plans!
- IC PREP KIT.
- PACKING NIGHT with parent performance.

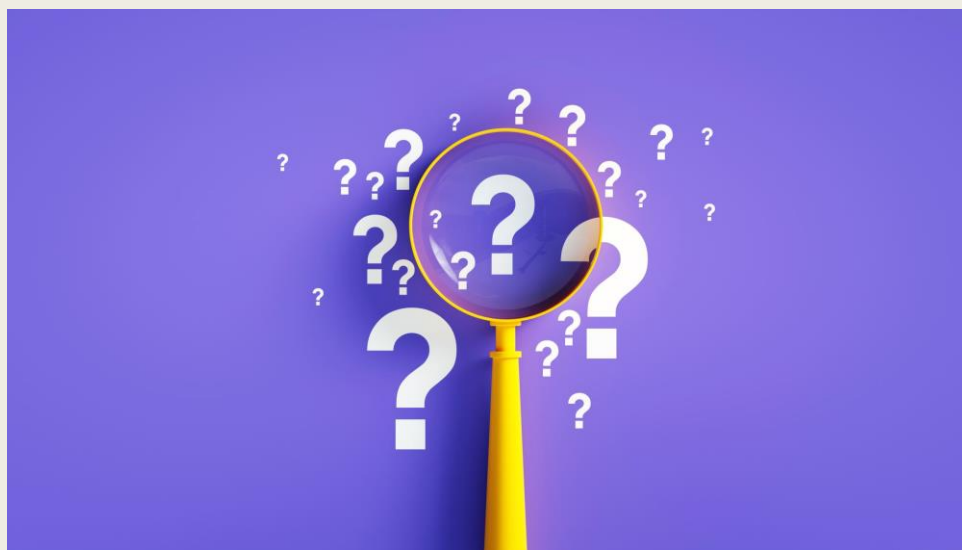
KANSAS CITY
