DISTRICT COORDINATOR/S REPORT: Michelle & Harry Oxrider

- 31 days til Regionals!
- Important announcement from HQ on 2/9
 - Global tournament is opening to everyone
 - If you sign up to go, you're considered "certified" to go to Globals
 - What does this mean to our teams and tournaments?
 - You would not be required to go to any regional or state tournament before going to globals
 - Highly recommended to go to both for experience
 - Don't see any impact on regionals
 - As of today, all of Region 12 is registered for regionals
 - May see a severe impact on State
 - Don't know who will be coming to state
 - We need to be thinking about our current by-laws and how they lay out funding teams
 - Will need to clarify our messaging and address who we fund and why
 - Suggestion for messaging: "Our bylaws were written to reflect the rules of the Global tournament and how teams qualify. As the Global tournament rules have now changed, we needed to take this into account and update our bylaws accordingly."
 - Globals are \$5,500/team
 - If you attend your affiliate tournament, you're entered into a raffle to get your Global costs refunded/taken care of
 - There is a possibility for our teams that state won't cost anything

Dress Rehearsal: Anita Pennington

- Sunday, March 6th – We have Magsig 1030a-4p
- Dee and Warren will assist, but still need volunteers to help work.
- Location - Ideally Magsig; Anita will reserve.
 - Still needs to submit building form for dress rehearsal
 - Harry submitted form and is working on getting confirmation
 - Waiting on custodial
- March 6th confirmed, 1030a-4p confirmed
 - 1030a-12: Configure performance spaces
 - 12p: Check in begins
 - 12:20p-315p: Performances
 - 3p – Last performance slot
 - 315 – 4p: Clean-up
- Sr. levels do not have to do dress rehearsal
 - RS, Elementary, Middle levels only
- Four performances spaces:
 - Stage - Improv & fine arts
 - Back Café – Tech teams and 3 RS
 - Front Café – Most of the Rising Stars
