



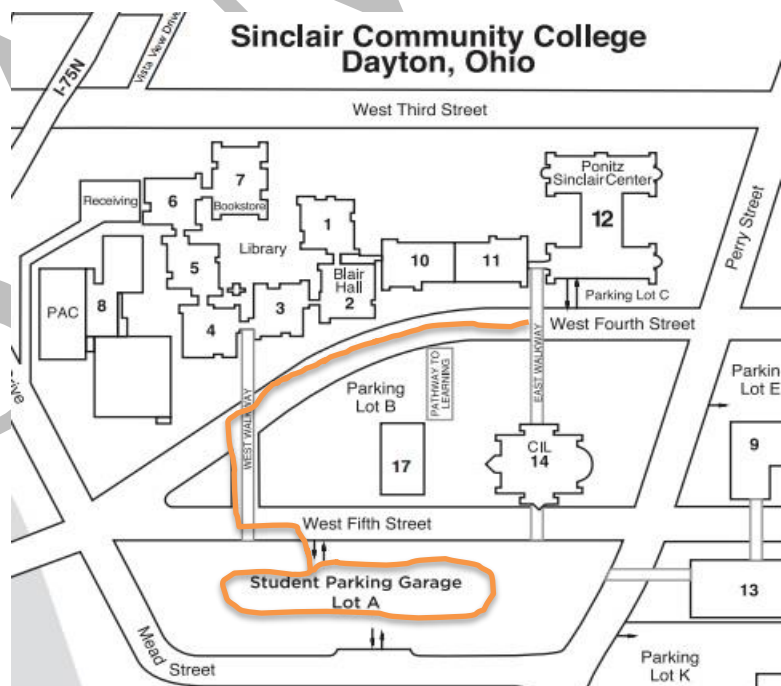

# DIRECTIONS!!

- TAKE **I-75 NORTH**
- **EXIT 52**, for I-35/Ohio 4/Eaton/Xenia
- Keep to the **RIGHT** and take the **I-35 EAST XENIA** exit ramp
- Once on I-35, you'll need to end up in the **LEFT LANE**
- Take **LEFT** exit, **Ohio 48/Main Street/Jefferson Street**
- Keep to the **RIGHT** and take the **RIGHT** side when the exit ramp forks.
- Turn **RIGHT** onto **JEFFERSON** (this is another "fork", so make sure to take the curve to the right from either the middle or right lanes).
- Get into the **LEFT LANE**.
- Turn **LEFT** onto **FOURTH STREET**.
- Get into **LEFT** lane. You'll be driving past/through the campus area.
- Right past the 2<sup>nd</sup> overhead walkway, turn **LEFT** onto **Fifth Street** (it's almost like a U-turn onto 5<sup>th</sup> Street in front of the garage). You'll go back under the walkway.
- Turn **RIGHT** into the garage. **PARKING IN THE GARAGE IS NOW A \$5 FEE.**
- You can either park in the lower levels and walk across the lot to the campus, or park on the upper floors to walk across the walkway, which will take you into Building #3. **ALL BUILDINGS ARE CONNECTED.**



## **SOUVENIR SALES!!**

There will be items for purchase in the **Lobby of Building 8**, outside the gymnasium. They typically have challenge-specific pins for sale (\$2 - \$3) and then “fun” items, like glow stick items, etc... This is set up right outside the gym where the Award Ceremony will be held, so be aware that (a) your child might get the “Buy Me's” and (b) their stock is limited so it's better to go earlier in the day if there is something specific you want to purchase (like the challenge pin).

*Cash or check sales; checks will need made out to Ohio Kids for Creativity, Region 12.*

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## **HUNGRY??**

The cafeteria in the **basement of Building 7** will be open for lunch and stay open until 4 pm for food purchases. This is a multi-station cafeteria with a variety of food options ranging from packaged salads to grill items.

## HELPFUL HINTS from the “BTDT Mom” <wink>

This is a loooong day for the kids - and us! Wear comfortable clothing & shoes. You will be walking across a campus, up & down steps, helping carry props, and comfort should trump fashion on this day. MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD/REN ALSO HAVE ON COMFORTABLE SHOES, because we do not want them to whine about needing to be carried LOL!

**Your child will need to wear their gold/yellow CENTERVILLE DI t-shirt** (with the dominos on it) that they were handed on Picture Day. They can wear jeans/sweats/leggings with it, whichever they prefer, and if cold, a long-sleeved shirt UNDER the gold team shirt. TIME TO CHANGE INTO, AND OUT OF, THEIR COSTUMES has been built into the schedule.

**YOU will need to supervise YOUR child.** They are too young to be on their own and we'll be torn between Ryan; team / team responsibilities; and what is going on with Patrick & Kevin. The parent who will stay with the child – it's easiest to just consider yourself a pack mule. I recommend a backpack or large tote bag that YOU carry so you don't have to worry about THEM leaving something behind. Plus, once they go off for their Central and Instant Challenges, you'll be in charge of their stuff anyway, so might as well just plan on it for the whole day!

- 1-2 bottles of **WATER**.
- A few **SNACKS** for the day – preferably something healthy that won't make them sick or bounce off the walls (please!) NO GUM OR CANDY (until after Instant Challenge)!
- **CASH**: If you want to purchase souvenirs, you can use cash or a check; but have cash on hand for vending machines and to pay the \$5 parking fee.
- **LUNCH**. If you don't plan to visit the cafeteria, please pack a lunch for you and your child. With the timing between watching sibling teams and moving between buildings, we will just gather in a building atrium, sit down & eat something.
- **QUIET ACTIVITY**: Okay, they are going to get bored. (And you are, too.) DI Day is a lot about hurrying up and waiting. Throw a scratch pad of paper and some pencils / pens in the backpack; a deck of cards or a card game like Uno; a book. You will see kids with DS's, tablets, etc... It is entirely UP TO YOU and at YOUR DISCRETION & RISK as to if you'd like to bring something expensive like that to Sinclair. Please do NOT bring something that would require them spreading out – you will find that in some of the buildings space can be at a premium in the hallways, so no board games, oversized coloring books, etc...

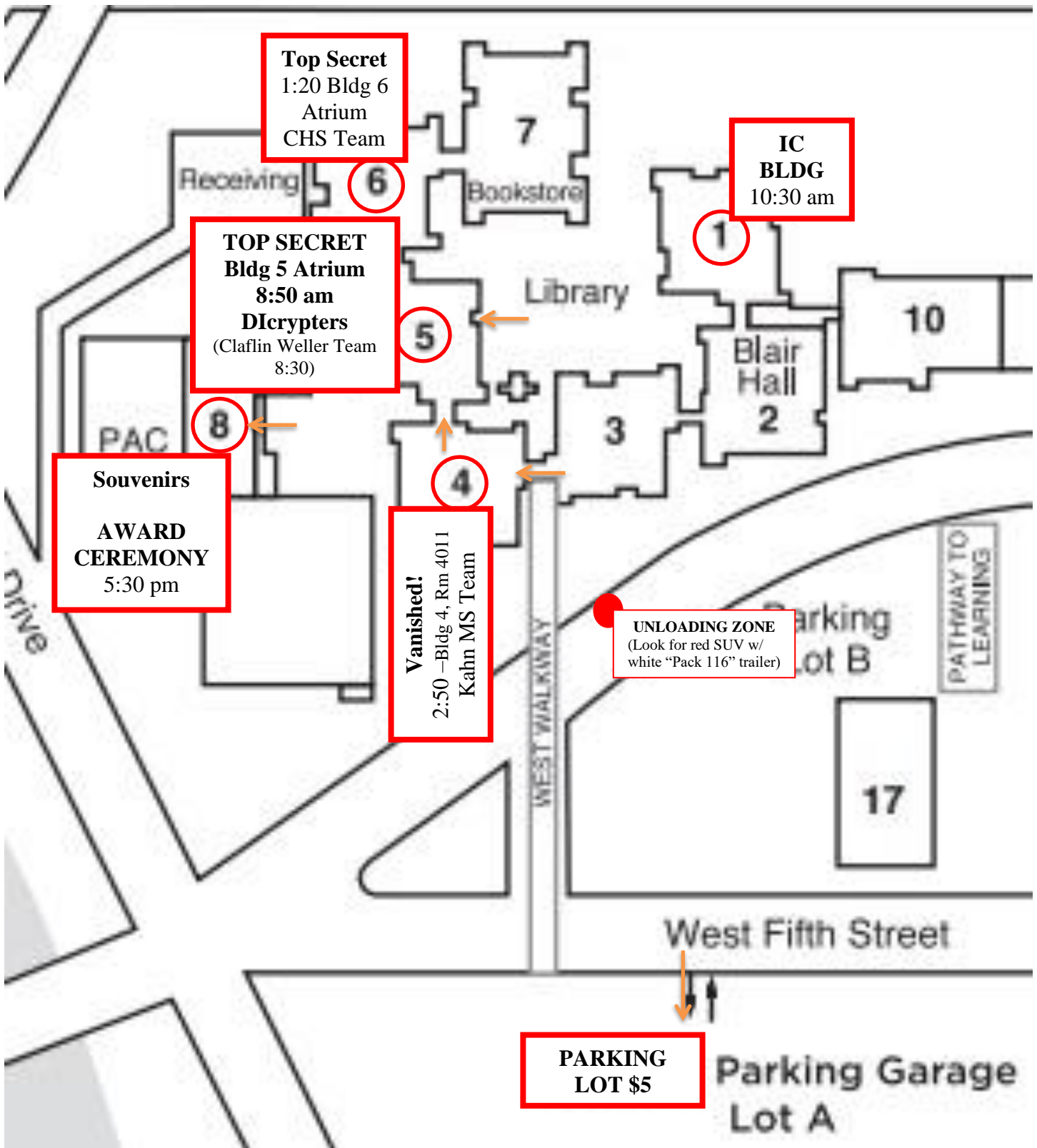
Once the kids are done with their Instant Challenge they are free to go. Your family is welcome to stay and hang with the team schedule or do your own thing – just let us know if you will be leaving and if you will be coming back for the Award Ceremony so we know to look for you!

THE AWARD CEREMONY IS NOT MANDATORY, but it's fun ☺!! During the Award Ceremony, the kids will sit on the gym floor with Mr. & Mrs. O and their teammates. You will see that all the Centerville kids tend to clump together (except for the high schoolers who tend to sit at the back to stay out of the fray & to be “cool”). After the Award Ceremony you will need to come down onto the floor; we will not allow the kids to leave unless their parent (NOT a sibling) is standing in front of or in sight of us.

**Key to locating rooms at Sinclair Community College:**

1<sup>st</sup> number (4235) = Building #

2<sup>nd</sup> number (4235) = floor in that building

3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> numbers (4235) = room number

For example: Room 5124 is in Building 5, 1<sup>st</sup> floor, room 24.

Additional hints: Floor 0 is the basement, floor L is the level below the basement.

So 4011 is Building 4, basement, room 11 and 2020 is Building 2, basement, room 12
