How does DI benefit my Special Needs student?

Special Needs teams focus on social interactions and communication with others, while fostering teamwork and building friendships. Students work on both fine & gross motor skills while learning life skills. Parents are highly encouraged to volunteer as Team Managers & be involved. Teams are formed based on the number of Team Managers.

2021-22 fee is \$55 with the remainder covered by a grant from the CDI Parent Support Group.



Who is eligible?

Any student that spends a percentage of their day in a Special Needs classroom, or is unable to participate on a typical team without adult assistance.
